Offering Daana-paani shows kindness, supports local bird populations in urban areas with limited natural resources, attracts nature, and holds religious merit.

To offer Daana-paani, you can provide grains, seeds, fruits, and unsalted nuts for food, avoiding harmful items like bread and salty foods. For water, use shallow dishes or bird baths, ensuring the water is clean and changed daily. 




- 1st Place: Rudra Saini (Vyas Blue House) impressed the judges with a quote that resonated with depth and originality.

Word Art Competition


