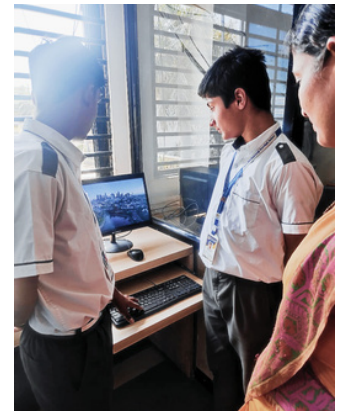

Rotating roles : Students can take turns being the "expert" on a specific topic or step, allowing everyone to contribute and learn from each other.

Learning basic coding can be an empowering experience that teaches a wide range of skills: creativity, problem-solving, perseverance, confidence, and more. Teaching coding to your students helps them to better understand how the modern world works, and perhaps, someday, shape the digital future. We are working on New coding application-:Scratch, code.
