Diwali Shivar Competitions

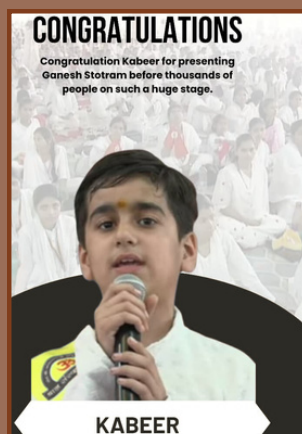

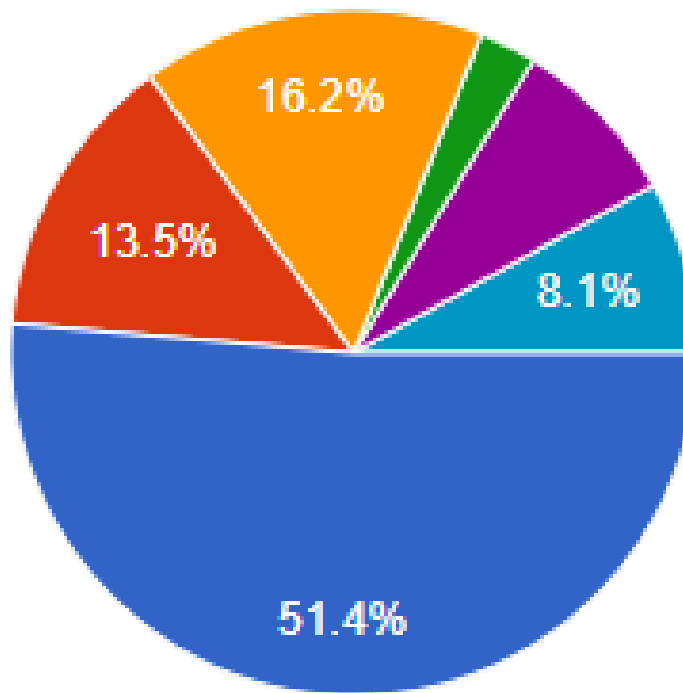

Yagya Katiwa (Class 9) – His calm and respectful behavior makes him Mr. Polite. Yagya always listens to his teachers attentively and never argues.

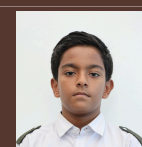
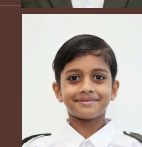
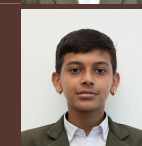
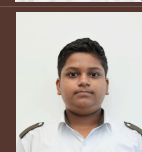
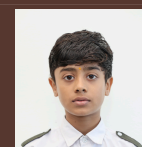
Anshuman Choudhary (Class 11) – Recognized as the Neat Writer, Anshuman's tidy work and elegant handwriting reflect his discipline and precision.
