Impressed by our performance and teamwork, the selectors chose us for the National-level competition. Reaching this level has been a proud and unforgettable moment for us.

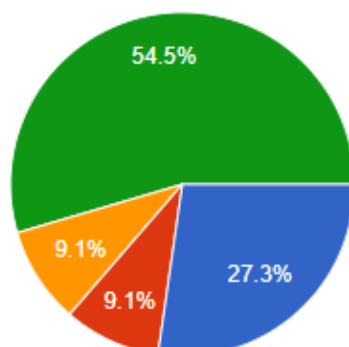
