Step into the New You

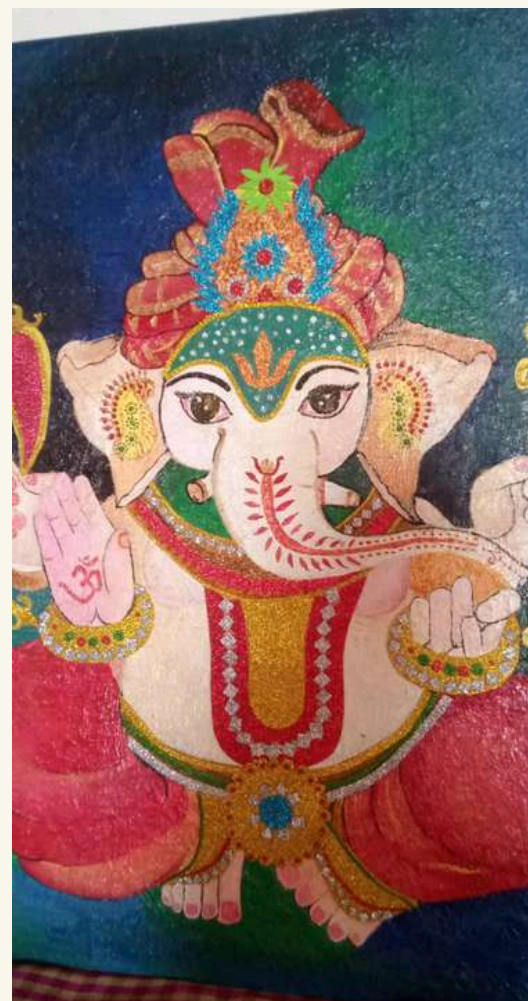
